



Fire and Ice Adult Pond Hockey Tournament Rules

- Games will be running-time and consist of two 15-minute halves. Teams will have five minutes to warmup before game and two-minute halftime.
- Each team is allowed four skaters on the ice at a time. Substitutions are made on the fly.
- All players must wear helmets and hockey skates. Full protective equipment is optional but highly recommended. No goalie equipment or goalie sticks are permitted.
- Teams must have light and dark jerseys. Home teams wear light jerseys.
- There will be one off-ice pond official for each game. Referee will track score, time, as well as infractions.
- Minor infractions will result in loss of possession. Referees may award a penalty shot if a penalty is deemed flagrant. Checking is not allowed. Any player issued a major penalty will be ejected from the tournament.
- Teams must "tag up" after each goal or infraction, all players on team must be on their half of the ice when the other team starts possession.
- Complete game and tournament rules will be posted on the AHA website and provided to team Captains prior to the tournament.
